LEWANNICK PARISH COUNCIL

Lewannick Parish Council met at Lewannick Village Hall on Wednesday 21 June. The Chairman was pleased to welcome our new councillor Mrs Jenny Potter. Cllr J Potter has signed the Notification by Member of a Local Authority of Financial and Other Interests: which was passed to the Clerk for onward submission to our monitoring officer. The Green at Polyphant and the maintenance thereof was discussed. It was agreed that Block One - which is adjacent to Coombe Barn - requires attention together with Block 3 - next to the Play Area. We are waiting for a full report on the trees for the next on-going maintenance programme. It was also agreed that we would apply for various grant-funding projects in order that we may increase this open space. Planning applications, which were supported are No 2006/00967 Revised Design to increase floor levels in accordance with dda requirements special care assisted living unit (1999/1421) Bowden Derra, Polyphant for Mr and Mrs D Cash and No 2006/01039 Alterations to openings and raising of roof height of store room, Lewannick Post Office, Lewannick for Mr A Leslie. For information Erection of one pair of semi-detached dwellings with parking spaces, land off Cottage Gardens, Lewannick has been approved by NDC together with Mr and Mrs W J K Woolridge, 12 Oak Tree Lodge, Demolition of existing conservatory and erection of replacement with sun room. The Play Area at Lewannick has sadly been vandalised. We are extremely

fortunate to have Cllr John Newbury who has kindly repaired this damage in order that the play area could be re-opened. It is up to all of us to monitor this area and report any nuisance behaviour. We have chased Tarmac in order to restart the liaison committee. The new Operations Manager would welcome the continuance of the liaison committee. The quarry would prefer the meetings to be held during the day. It was felt strongly that dialogue needs to be kept going in light of the junction and increased activity at the quarry. Our two representatives will be Cllr John Panter and our Chairman Cllr Iris Curley.

We have also written to our Divisional Surveyor, Mr S Ewing requesting improvements to the pavement outside of the Archers Arms and this request has been acknowledged.

There is still a problem with dog fouling and indeed complaints have been received about dogs roaming and becoming a nuisance. This has been reported to our Dog Warden.

Our next meeting will be held at Polyphant Village Hall on Wednesday 19 July the meeting will commence at 8pm and prior to this meeting Councillors will be carrying out a full inspection of Polyphant Green.
