Lewannick Parish Council did not meet in August. Our next meeting is scheduled for Wednesday 19 September. The meeting will commence at 7pm with an invited speaker who will discuss the implications of "One Cornwall". Our Ordinary Meeting will follow commencing 8pm.

Although we had no meeting in August we have two items of news to report. Following successful lobbying from us, Cornwall County Council have agreed a works order package for improvements to the junction and pavement adjacent to The Archer Arms in Lewannick. This alteration is intended to improve road safety for pedestrians and road users. Unfortunately the plans received were drawn up without consultation, as promised, and are unacceptable. We will discuss this at our next meeting and arrange a site meeting.

We are pleased to inform you that we have been successful in our bid for grant funding from Cornwall Aggregates and have now submitted a project for improved safety railing to the War Memorial and Play equipment at Lewannick.
