Lewannick Parish Council met at Lewannick Village Hall on Wednesday 15 April 2009. The meeting commenced at 20.00hours. Planning applications, which were all supported, included 2009/00409 Retrospective application for the alteration of lawned garden into hard standing for private parking and raise height of garden wall to 6 feet to match existing garden walls. Sunholme, Lewannick Mr A Leslie. 2009/00389 Charmwell, Lewannick Mr S Penhale erection of extension to side of dwelling and alterations. We have had confirmation from CC that the development of Lewannick Community Primary School Phase 1 has been granted. A meeting with joint parish councils was recently held at South Petherwin in order to highlight various highway matters and most importantly Trekelland Bridge. Although a number of excellent proposals were put forward money, of course, is the fundamental stumbling block.

We are pleased that the swing has now been erected at Polyphant Play Area and we very much hope that the children within the parish will enjoy this new facility.

We are saddened to have to report that there has been an incident with regard to the trees that have been cut at Polyphant. It was agreed with our contractor that the wood cut would be taken away by our contractor as part of the agreed contract/payment. The matter is being investigated.
