Lewannick Parish Council News

Lewannick Parish Council met at Polyphant on Wednesday 17 June 2009. The meeting began with an introduction to our Community Network Manager, Mark O'Brien and an informal discussion about his new role. He will be assisting 18 parish councils/town councils in the Callington/Launceston area. It is hoped that a networking evening at Launceston Town Hall will take place shortly when Mark will be able to give a full presentation on delivering services to the community. It has been decided that the sad event of the theft of the Hornbeam, which was planted at Polyphant, needed to be reported to the police. We have now done this and it is understood that they will be making further enquiries.

There were no planning applications for consideration. Notice of approval for Development has been received for 5 Penmay House, Bell Meadow, Lewannick - construction of a car port - Mr F Werring, No. 2009/00501. Land adjacent, The Old Post Office, Lewannick - erection of two affordable homes with parking areas - No.2008/01899 - Mr R Parnell and Miss D Strout and Mr C Ward and Miss K Parnell. Prior Notification for the construction of two agricultural storage barns at Trenhorne, Congdons Shop - No. 2009/00603 - Ms Debra Richardson. Application for Prior Notification for the siting of and agricultural shed for the storage of hay and straw - No. 2009/00567 - Mrs Shirley Jasper.

Invoices for payment included Newsletter £315.00 for half year. £594.10 Allianz Insurance. £22.00 BJV for the maintenance of bus shelter. Grants have been awarded to: Launceston and District Over 50's £200.00., Lewannick Website £500.00, Lewannick Film Society £300.00, Lewannick Church £400.00, Polyphant Church £400.00, Trevadlock Cemetery £150.00 and our Big Lunch mural £50.00. It should be noted that we have received grant funding from Cornwall Aggregates of £4000 which assisted us in purchasing the swing at Polyphant and an oak notice board for Lewannick.
