## Lewannick Parish Council News

Lewannick Parish Council met at Lewannick Village Hall on Wednesday 21 April. The meeting commenced at 20.00hours. Two benches have been removed from Polyphant Green and we are hopeful that they will be replaced soon. They have been ordered and it is anticipated that they will be delivered within a six week period. The benches are teak and extremely robust.

We still have concerns with respect to fly tipping especially within the area of Stoney Lane, Lewannick and we request residents to please report anything that may be suspicious. Cllrs are also concerned about the level of litter within our parish. A Clean Lewannick Parish Group is being organised under the management of Cllr Michael Cook and if there are any residents who would like to assist with this group please contact Michael direct or any member of the council. More importantly, of course, we urge residents and visitors to take their litter home with them. We have a Blackhill Quarry Local Liaison Group Meeting on 5 May.

We had two planning applications for discussion, both of which have been supported, namely:- Conversion of existing attached garage into an annexe, enlarge front porch, construct a conservatory and demolish existing garage and construct new garage, SHILDON, POLYPHANT, Mr M Shillaber and Construction of replacement dwelling following demolition of existing substandard extensions, through the incorporation and retention of the main elements of the existing dwelling and the erection of new elements to form a new dwelling, Trelaske Manor, Mr T Z Doak 2010/00312. We had a meeting with Richard White, Planning Officer, on Thursday 22 April which was held in conjunction with neighbouring parish councils. This proved to be extremely informative and helpful.

Our insurance for the year has also been reviewed and £629.74 paid.

We have a meeting with Highways on 12 May 2010 at Tolpetherwin when among other items the junction at Plusha will be discussed.

Our Annual Parish Meeting will be held on Wednesday 19 May at Polyphant Village Hall. The meeting will commence at 19.30 hours. We would welcome reports from all organisations within our parish. This will assist us with our Parish Plan and planning for the future. We very much wish to hear and consider the aspirations of the parish and this is your opportunity to come along and help us to make our parish one that is led by the community.

## CRIMINAL DAMAGE AT LEWANNICK PRIMARY SCHOOL

During the Easter holiday, several trees in the grounds of Lewannick Primary School were cut down. This included two small fruit trees and a mature tree, either a Cherry or Rowan, which was at least 15 years old. The trees, which were situated in the north east corner of the playing field, were discovered by Tim Ellis on the 18 April when he cut the grass the day before school re-opened.

The Police have been informed and will be investigating, as this is an act of criminal damage as well as being senseless vandalism and has saddened the school and village.

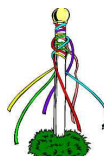
