- (a) 2009/01221 Tinney Hall Barn, Lewannick, Mr David Teer – Single storey garden room extension – proposed by B O’N 2<sup>nd</sup> DP all in agreement that we support the application.
- (b) 2009/011932 Trewanta Hall Farm Bungalow, Trewanta Hall Farm, Lewannick, Mr and Mrs B J Balsdon – single storey extensions comprising porch, family room and bedroom with en-suite shower room – Pro B O’N 2<sup>nd</sup> DP all in agreement that we support the application.

(C )2009/00893 Mr Gill – Longcroft, Congdons Shop – Two storey extension with a single storey glazed link between existing building and proposed extension – withdrawn.

(d ) 2008/002258 Mr White – approval for the erection of 16 affordable housing units and a doctors’ surgery on an exception site together with the conversion of 2 existing barns into dwellings and a further two new private dwellings within the development boundary. This application was further discussed and Cllrs were mindful that there should be a mix of properties to purchase and to rent. **(7) ANY OTHER BUSINESS**

- (a) DE advised that rats had appeared in the bins at the village hall, Lewannick and that residents were concerned about vehicles speeding through the village.
- (b) J Pa raised concerns that the planning applications were not appearing in the Cornish and Devon Post. PP agreed that it was a problem for many residents and that the issue had already been raised with CC. He was waiting to hear back.
- (c) B O’N in 2001 there would be a review of post offices. The Lsn and District Over 50’s Voice had already joined with Cornwall to set-up a group to fight the possible closures.
- (d) DP – Two Bridges slip road by café – area a hazard. PP readily agreed and stated that Altarnun, South Petherwin and Lewannick Parish Councils, Police and Highways Agency would be discussing the Plusha Junction on Tuesday 6 October 7pm at Altarnun Parish Hall. The Two Bridges slip road could also be included. It was hoped that Cllrs would be able to attend.
- (e) Adoption of Telephone Boxes – it was agreed that we would adopt Lewannick and Polyphant telephone boxes – proposed B O’N 2<sup>nd</sup> DE all in full agreement.
